

A GUIDE TO THE CONFERENCE SUPERBOWL

CYYAC24 CONFERENCE SUPERBOWL

Historically, the Youth Conference and Connectional Youth and Young Adult Conferences have had some way of involving all youth in the conference. This year, the CYYAC24 SuperBowl will be a competition where all youth can compete against one another or in teams to receive awards as judged by pre-selected judges. The Conference Bowls will be presented in person and as a Preconference event.

Throughout the preparation for CYYAC24, we will be promoting the "Conference SuperBowl" where youth will be able to participate in different venues. These venues are called Bowls and will take place on Monday, July 1, 2024, prior to the opening of the conference. All Bowl submissions must be appropriate and in good taste. All music, language, and dress must be void of vulgarity, profanity and obscenity. Secular music may be used in the presentation but must be void of profanity. Youth are encouraged to register for multiple competitions. The deadline for all entries is May 15, 2024. Entries will not be accepted after the entry deadline. The Conference SuperBowl will be broken down into three categories: Academic, Visual Arts, and Performance Bowls. The individual Bowls are labeled as follows:

ACADEMIC BOWLS:

Bible Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to participate in learning about the Bible. Participants will be required to study and answer a series of questions from the Bible in preparation for a live 'Bible Bowl' event.

CME Church Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to learn CME church history/polity and using this knowledge, think of ways they can become active disciples in the CME church. Participants will be required to study and answer a series of questions about the CME Church in preparation for a live 'CME Church Bowl' event.

Essay Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to create an essay based on the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Participants will create an essay of 400 to 600 words on how he/she relates to the theme and scripture.

Movie Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to find meaning in movies. Five movies will be designated with questions posed regarding meaning found in the movie. Participants will select one of the five movies to view and submit a short synopsis that answers the questions and tells how their selected movie relates to the conference theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Poetry Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to create poetry based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit original poetry relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

VISUAL ARTS BOWLS:

Creative Design/Fashion Bowl – will give youth an opportunity to design and create clothing and accessories that represents the theme of "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Cyber Bowl – will give youth an opportunity to create and present a chosen form of technology that speaks to them and to the theme of "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged). The acceptable forms of technology include but are not limited to coding, game art design, and animation.

Street Art Bowl – will give youth the opportunity to participate in relational evangelism by submitting original artwork that relates to the conference theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) and suggests ways to take action that moves beyond the local church.

Video/Filmmaking Bowl – will give youth an opportunity to create and produce a video or short movie that speaks to the theme of "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

PERFORMANCE BOWLS:

Hymn Memorization – will give youth an opportunity to learn lyrics while studying the importance of hymns throughout the history of the Christian Church and the CME Church that represent the theme of "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Monologue Bowl — will give youth an opportunity to create and perform a monologue based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original Monologue relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Original Composition Bowl – will give youth the opportunity to create a song based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants will be required to submit an original song with proof of copyright relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Rap Bowl — will give youth the opportunity to create and perform Rap music based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original Rap relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Spoken Word – will give youth the opportunity to create a Spoken Word performance based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original Spoken word performance relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged).

Worship Theater Bowl – will give youth the opportunity to create and perform a worship presentation using various worship art forms (puppetry, mime, liturgical dance, dramatic expression, and/or sign language). Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit a video of an original worship presentation.

ACADEMIC BIBLE BOWL

Guidelines

The Bible Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to participate in learning about the Bible. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to study a set of questions from the Bible and will be required to answer the questions in preparation for a live 'Bible Bowl' event.

Participants

The Bible Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Bible Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. Participants will receive a study packet to help prepare them for the competition.

Round One will be conducted using game-based learning technology. Participants who have submitted an interest in this Bowl will participate in a preconference 'Bible Bowl' event at a designated time. Successful participants will advance to the final round live onsite in a series of single and double matches. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference.

ACADEMIC CME CHURCH BOWL

Guidelines

The CME Church Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to learn about the CME church and using this knowledge, think about how they can become active disciples in the CME church. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to study and answer a series of questions about the CME Church in preparation for a live 'CME Church Bowl' event.

Participants

The CME Church Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating CME Church Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. Participants will receive a study packet to help prepare them for the competition.

Round One will be conducted using game-based learning technology. Participants who have submitted an interest in this Bowl will participate in a pre-conference 'CME Church Bowl' event at a designated time. Successful participants will advance to the final round live onsite in a series of single and double matches. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference.

ACADEMIC ESSAY BOWL

Guidelines

The Essay Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create an essay based on the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to create an essay on how he/she relates to the theme. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of essay content to the conference theme, (3) Organization and clarity, (4) Grammar, punctuation and spelling, and (5) the essay must be 400 – 600 words.

Participants

The Essay Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit the essay and a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Essay Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024.** Essay submissions must include a cover sheet which includes the writer's name, church name and pastor, and current grade level. The submission must be typed or legibly handwritten.

The submitted works will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will make preliminary selection of the top participants and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference.

ACADEMIC MOVIE BOWL

Guidelines

The Movie Bowl will give CYYAC24 Youth registrants the opportunity to find meaning in the movies. Five movies will be designated with questions posed regarding meaning found in the movie. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be emailed movie selections and associated questions regarding meaning in the movie. Participants will select a movie and submit a short synopsis that answers the questions and tells how their selected movie relates to the conference theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. (Participants may also select a movie of their own choice and submit a short synopsis of that movie and how it relates to the conference theme). Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of movie meaning to the conference theme, and (3) Movie Synopsis must be no more than 400 words.

Participants

The Movie Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit the movie synopsis and completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Movie Bowl) by mail or email to cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org by **May 15, 2024**. Movie synopsis submissions must include a cover sheet which includes the writer's name, church name and pastor, and current grade level. The submission must be typed or legibly handwritten.

The submitted works will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will make preliminary selection of the top participants and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. If enough interest is received, a movie viewing and discussion time will be arranged during the pre-conference events.

ACADEMIC POETRY BOWL

Guidelines

The Poetry Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create poetry based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit original poetry relating to the theme conference theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of poetry content to the conference theme, and (3) Poetry must be no more than 400 words.

Participants

The Poetry Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit the poetry and a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Poetry Bowl) by mail or email to cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org by May 15, 2024. Poetry submissions must include a cover sheet which includes the writer's name, church name and pastor, and current grade level. The submission must be typed or legibly handwritten.

The submitted works will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will make preliminary selection of the top participants and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. All submissions will be available for viewing on the virtual platform.

VISUAL ARTS

CREATIVE DESIGN/FASHION BOWL

Guidelines

The Creative Design/Fashion Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create clothing and accessories that represent the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Acceptable forms include but are not limited to clothing, jewelry, handbags, and accessories. Each Creative Design/Fashion Bowl submission must include an original sketch and picture of the completed item. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality and (2) Relation of the Creative Design/Fashion creation to the conference theme.

Participants

The Creative Design/Fashion Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Creative Design/Fashion Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024.** The submission form, original sketch, and picture must be emailed or submitted by DVD, CD, or flash drive.

The submitted works will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will review and rate the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. There will be a designated time for display/presentation of the creative design/fashion creations during the pre-conference.

VISUAL ARTS CYBER BOWL

Guidelines

The Cyber Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create a chosen form of technology that speaks to them and to the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Acceptable forms include but are not limited to coding, game art design and animation. Each Cyber Bowl submission must include instruction on how to open it for viewing. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of the Cyber creation to the conference theme, and (3) Each Cyber creation has a time limit of no more than 10 minutes.

Participants

The Cyber Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Cyber Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024.** The submission form and cyber entry must be emailed or submitted by DVD, CD, or flash drive.

The submitted works will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will review and rate the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. There will be a designated time for display/presentation of the cyber creations during the preconference.

VISUAL ARTS STREET ART BOWL

Guidelines

The Street Art Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to participate in relational evangelism. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit original artwork that relates to the conference theme. The artwork may suggest ways to live out your faith being "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. These submissions should represent some form of art and can include but are not limited to collages, drawings, paintings, pictures, photos, posters, pottery, and sculptures. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, and (2) Relation of the submission to the conference theme.

Participants

The Street Art Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Street Art Bowl) by mail or email to cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org by May 15, 2024. The submission form and a photo of the original artwork entry must be emailed electronically.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions. and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. Participants will be able to view all submitted artwork in an Art Gallery on a virtual platform and onsite Gallery Walk.

VISUAL ARTS VIDEO/FILMMAKING BOWL

Guidelines

The Video/Filmmaking Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create and produce a video or short movie that speaks to the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each video/filmmaking submission must include instructions on how to open it for viewing. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of the video/film content to the conference theme, and (3) Each submission has a time limit of not more than ten (10) minutes.

Participants

The Video/Filmmaking Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Video/Filmmaking Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. The submission form and entry must be emailed or submitted by DVD, CD, or flash drive.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions. and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. The video or short films may be shown before sessions and will be accessible on a virtual platform where conference participants will be able to view the submissions.

PERFORMANCE HYMN MEMORIZATION BOWL

Guidelines

The Hymn Memorization Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to learn lyrics while studying the importance of hymns throughout the history of the Christian Church and the CME Church that represent the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Memorizing hymns is one of the ways we can obey Scripture's command to "let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God" (Col. 3:16). Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to study a set of hymns and will be required to answer the questions in preparation for a live 'Hymn Memorization Bowl'.

Participants

The Hymn Memorization Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Hymn Memorization Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. Participants will receive a study guide to help prepare for the bowl.

Round One will be conducted using game-based learning technology. Participants who have submitted an interest in this Bowl will participate in a pre-conference 'Bible Bowl' event at a designated time. Successful participants will advance to the final round live onsite in a series of single and double matches. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference.

PERFORMANCE MONOLOGUE BOWL

Guidelines

The Monologue Bowl will give CYYAC24 youth registrants the opportunity to create and perform a monologue based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original monologue video with a subject relating to the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity, (2) Relation of the Monologue content to the conference theme, and (3) The Monologue presentation has a time limit of not more than four (4) minutes.

Participants

The Monologue Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Monologue Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. The submission form and a recording of the monologue performance on DVD or a flash drive must be received.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. Youth participant submissions may be shown before sessions, accessible on virtual platform, and opportunities to perform live during youth social events.

PERFORMANCE ORIGINAL COMPOSITION BOWL

Guidelines

The Original Composition Bowl will give youth registrants the opportunity to write and perform an original song based on the CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to provide proof of copyright. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity/Originality, (2) Relation of the Original Composition content to the conference theme, and (3) The Original Composition presentation has a time limit of not more than six (6) minutes.

Participants

The Original Composition Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Original Composition Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. The submission form and audio/video recording of the original composition performance on flash drive or electronic submission must be received.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. Youth participant submissions may be used as fillers during the conference worship services, shown before sessions, accessible on virtual platform, and opportunities to perform live during youth social events.

PERFORMANCE RAP BOWL

Guidelines

The Rap Bowl will give youth registrants the opportunity to create Rap music based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original Rap video with a subject relating to the theme CYYAC24 theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity, (2) Relation of the Rap content to the conference theme, and (3) The Rap presentation has a time limit of not more than four (4) minutes.

Participants

The Rap Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Rap Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. The submission form, rap music lyrics, and a performance recording on flash drive or electronic submission must be received.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. Youth participant submissions may be shown before sessions, accessible on virtual platform, and opportunities to perform live during youth social events.

PERFORMANCE SPOKEN WORD BOWL

Guidelines

The Spoken Word Bowl will give CYYAC24 Youth registrants the opportunity to create a Spoken Word presentation based on the theme of CYYAC24. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original Spoken Word presentation relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity, (2) Relation of the Spoken Word content to the conference theme, and (3) The Spoken Word presentation has a time limit of not more than four (4) minutes.

Participants

The Spoken Word Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure

To enter the bowl, youth must submit a completed Bowl Submission Form (indicating Spoken Word Bowl) by mail or email to <u>cyyacbowls@thecmechurch.org</u> by **May 15, 2024**. The submission form and a recording of the Spoken Word performance on flash drive or electronic submission must be received.

The submitted work will be evaluated by a pre-conference panel of judges who will rate and select the top three submissions and onsite conference attendees will select the winners. Through the process of elimination the top three winners (Gold, Silver, & Bronze) will be determined and announced during the conference. Youth participant submissions may be shown before sessions, accessible on virtual platform, and opportunities to perform live during youth social events.

PERFORMANCE WORSHIP THEATER BOWL

Guidelines

The Worship Theater Bowl will give youth registrants the opportunity to create and perform a worship experience using various worship art forms (puppetry, mime, dramatic expression, liturgical dance and/or sign language). The worship theater presentation should be based on the CYYAC24 theme. Participants who submit an interest in this bowl will be required to submit an original presentation relating to the theme "F.R.E.E." (Focused Renewed Empowered Engaged) from John 8:31-32. Each submission will be evaluated based on the following: (1) Creativity, (2) Relation of the Worship Theater content to the conference theme, and (3) The Worship Theater presentation has a time limit of not more than six (6) minutes.

Participants

The Worship Theater Bowl is open to all CYYAC24 registrants, male or female, between the ages of 12 and 18. Submissions will be grouped in the following categories:

Junior High (grades 6th – 8th) Senior High School (grades 9th – 12th)

Procedure
